If your trash pickup day does NOT fall on a day that we are closed for a holiday, your trash will be emptied on your regular day. **Trash is collected weekly.**

If your trash pickup day falls on any of the following holidays, it will be emptied on the alternate date listed below.

Please place your trashcan at the street by **5:00 a.m.** on your collection day with the white serial numbers facing the street, and a four-foot clearance around the can. With employees running double routes, containers may be emptied late in the day. **If your trash is not emptied on the above listed day, please leave your container at the street and call Public Works at (931) 388-8650 the following business day.** Please remove all containers from the street after they have been emptied, per City ordinance.

Please note that we post this information preceding each holiday in the Daily Herald, on orange "Sanitation" signs around affected Routes, and on our Facebook and Instagram pages. Collection calendars are posted on our website and social media pages.
